Freshman year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Do well in academic course work. Maintain a high undergraduate grade point average and remain in the University Honors program.</li><li>• Seek advice/counsel from an academic advisor.</li><li>• Talk to lawyers and law students about their law school experiences.</li><li>• Attend special events at SIU Law.</li></ul>
Sophomore year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Continue strong academic preparation.</li><li>• Become involved in a pre-law society.</li><li>• Enroll in UHON 450.</li><li>• Research traditional and non-traditional legal careers to learn more about the legal profession.</li><li>• Contact the SIU Law admissions office to learn more about the JD program.</li></ul>
Junior year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Continue strong academic preparation.</li><li>• Enroll in PHIL 310 in preparation for the LSAT.</li><li>• Register for the June LSAT (lsac.org).</li><li>• Register for the Law School Admission Council's Credential Assembly Service (CAS) when you register for the LSAT.</li><li>• Purchase additional LSAT preparation materials, if necessary.</li><li>• Keep your undergraduate grade point average as high as possible.</li><li>• Take the LSAT in June.</li><li>• Send all college transcripts to LSAC.</li></ul>
Senior year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Continue strong academic preparation.</li><li>• Submit your academic materials to SIU Law.</li><li>• Follow up with the SIU Law admissions office to ensure that your file is complete.</li><li>• Register to attend an upcoming open house event.</li><li>• Complete FAFSA for the next academic year.</li></ul>
